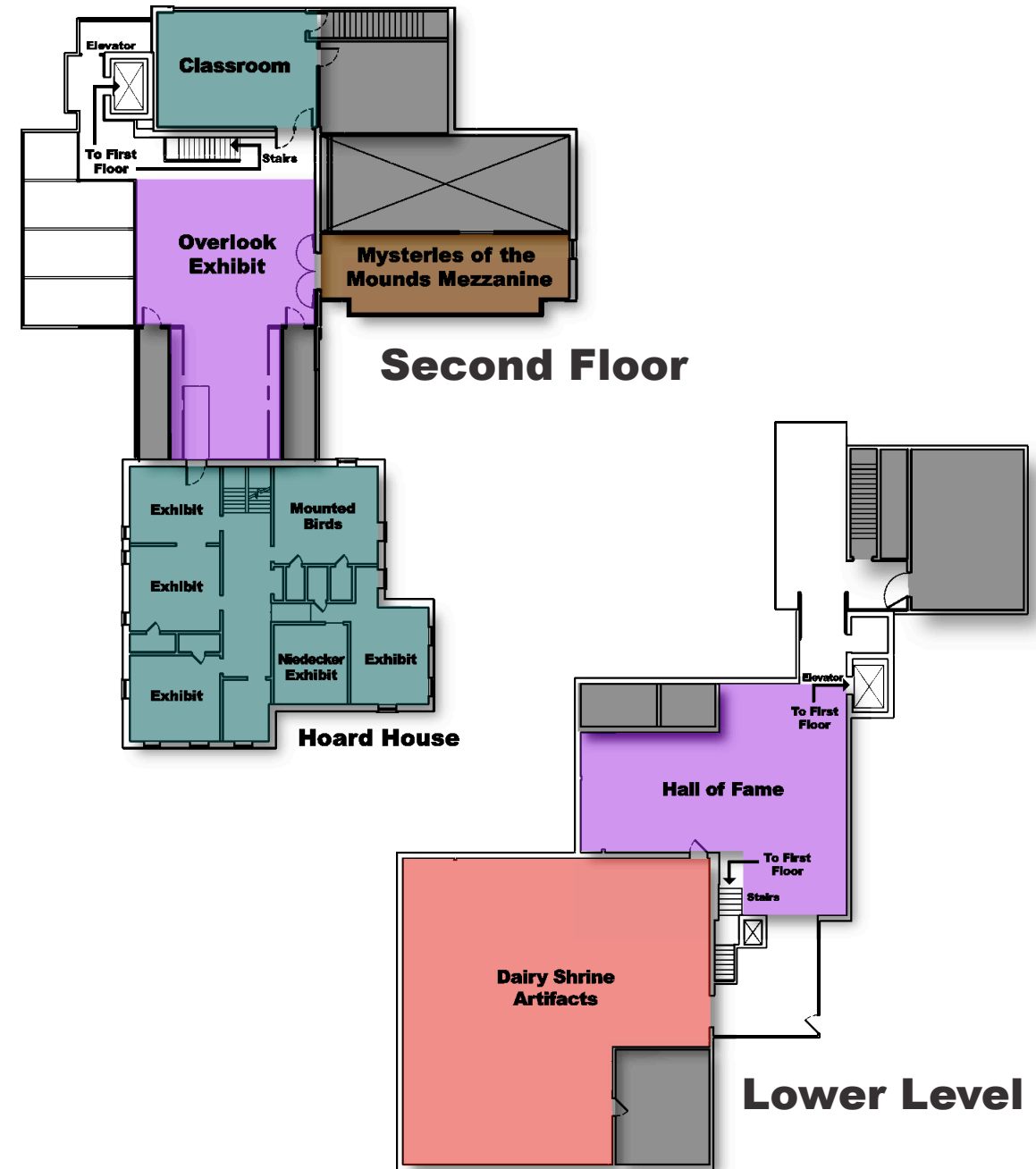
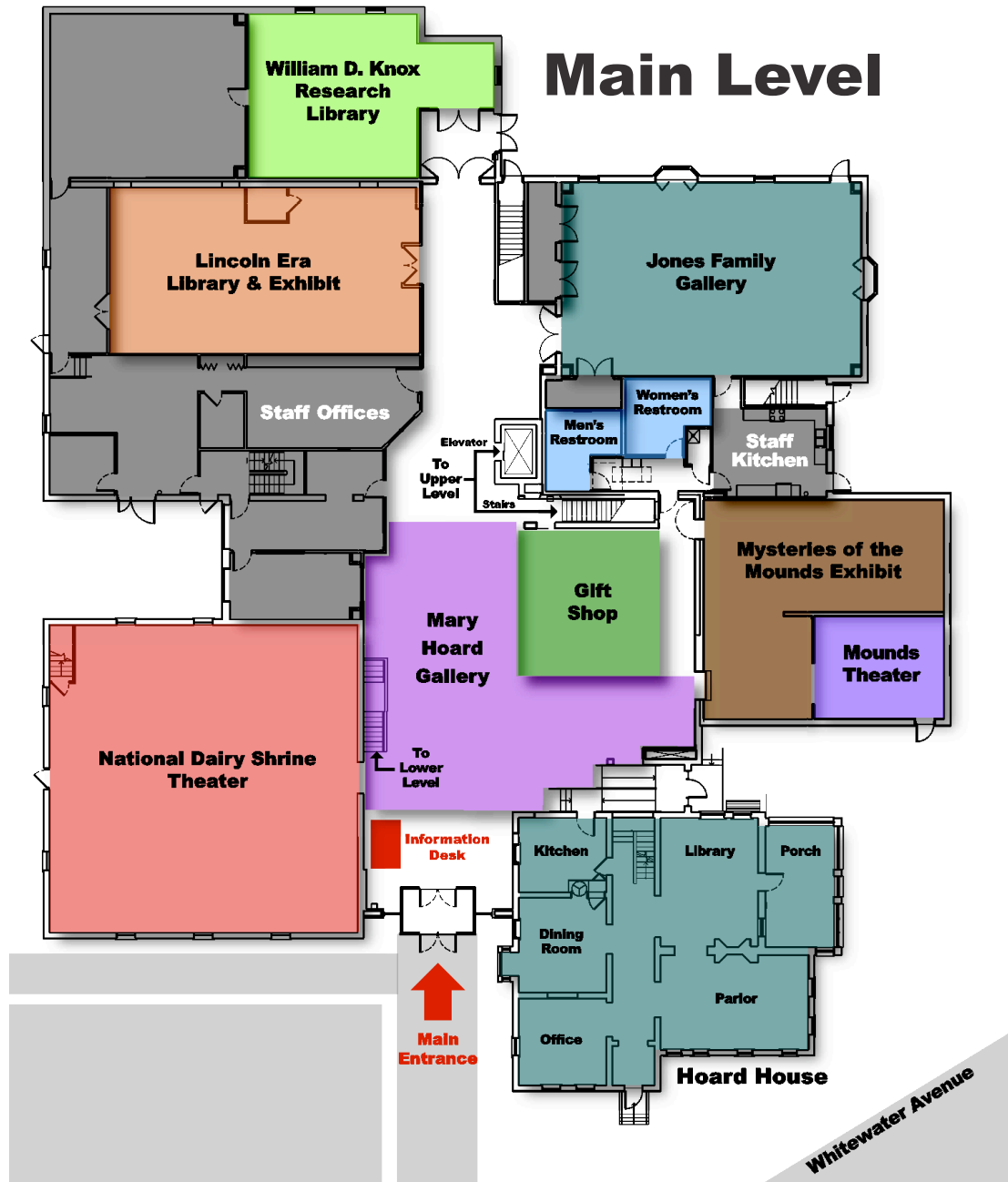
## Welcome to the Hoard Historical Museum and the National Dairy Shrine's Visitors Center
